



HOLE	STROKE	PAR	RULES
1		2	The objective of the game is to complete all 18 holes taking the fewest possible strokes. To tee off, place the ball on the tee off mat.
2		2	
3		2	
4		2	Each stroke taken counts as one.
5		2	NO more than 7 strokes on each hole.
6		3	
7		3	A ball leaving the track should be replaced at the point of leaving, but a penalty of 1 extra stroke must be scored.
8		3	A ball lying against a track perimeter may be moved one club's head length to enable play to continue.
9		2	
10		3	
11		3	On tracks 7, 10 and 15, if the ball rolls back a second non counted tee-off stroke is allowed.
12		2	
13		2	Don't walk on the green playing surface. You may carefully step onto this surface to play a stroke when necessary.
14		3	
15		3	Don't play strokes from the grass or paths.
16		3	
17		3	Don't use clubs as walking sticks or hammers.
18		2	
TOT		45	NO more than 7 strokes on each hole.
