Wanneroo Botanical Gardens

We recommend that the teacher in charge retains a copy of this document and is familiar with the procedures prior to your visit. It is also recommended to have a list of the names of all students and supervisory staff in the event a roll call is necessary.

Wanneroo Botanical Gardens has normal mobile phone reception. We advise that the school supervisory team have mobile phones for use during the excursion. The teacher in charge must supply their mobile number to the Schools Coordinator on arrival.

All senior staff at Wanneroo Botanical Gardens are trained in evacuation procedures and our first priority is to ensure the safety of our visitors.

Emergency Response Plan

In the event of an emergency all visitors should remain clear of trees and buildings and follow this plan:

- 1. Students are to make their way back to their allocated supervisor.
- 2. The allocated supervisor is to conduct a head count and when the total is correct, take their group QUICKLY and CALMLY to the grassed area at the eastern end of the car park.
- The teacher in charge must complete a role call and report any missing person IMMEDIATELY to Wanneroo Botanical Gardens staff.
- 4. Wanneroo Botanical Gardens staff will coordinate a sweep of the park, checking toilets, gardens and the café for any missing person.

Park Rules

It takes a team of gardeners working 112 hours a week to keep our gardens looking beautiful, but it only takes a few minutes of thoughtlessness to destroy them.

Please respect our gardens by following these simple rules:

- 1. No running or walking through the garden beds, please use the paths
- 2. No picnicking on the grass
- 3. Golf clubs are not to be used to knock holes in the lawn, trees or decapitate flowers
- 4. Animals and sporting equipment are prohibited in the park
- 5. Do not pick flowers or take cuttings

Supervisors will be asked to remove students found behaving inappropriately.
